Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our whole-school commitment to improving literacy and promoting a lifelong love of reading at Aston Manor Academy, this year we are inviting the Scholastic book fair into school.

We recognise that access to bookshops is not necessarily easy for much of our community, and by bringing the Scholastic book fair into school, we hope to remove one of the barriers families experience with obtaining good quality literature for their children to read.

The book fair will be in school from Friday 10th March until Friday 17th March, and all students in school will be given an opportunity to browse the exciting collection of brand new titles available to buy. We are also opening our doors to families on the afternoon of Wednesday 15th March, from 3.30p.m until 5.30p.m, should you wish to come and browse the collection yourself, or have a look at the vast collection of books available to loan in our exciting school library.

All books sold through the scholastic fair are offered at a discounted rate of £1 less than the RRP – meaning they are cheaper than they will be on the shelves in traditional bookstores. We will be running a cashless system, meaning that parents wishing to purchase books can do so at their leisure, online through the scholastic website. Students will be able to complete a 'Wish List' in School with a code that parents can reference when placing orders online. The Scholastic website will be available on the Wish List. Books will be delivered to school and distributed to students.

As part of this year's World Book Day, we are also offering prizes for students who engage with our various competitions, meaning that some students will be able to choose books from the fair as their prize, too, so please encourage your child to participate in the challenges we set!
